Poster Board Instructions: Create a poster board displaying each task below

1. Choose ONE ancient Egyptian God from *The Kane Chronicles* series.
2. Choose which book you choose your selection from.
3. Identify the Name of the Egyptian God. Example:

Seshat

4. Identify the title of the Egyptian God. Example:

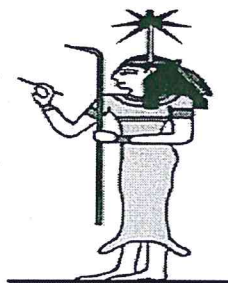
Lady of the Library

5. Identify what this Egyptian God represents in the polytheistic religion. Example:

GoddeSS of reading, writing, architecture, and math. Seshat plays an important role in a ceremony called "stretching the cord" in which she assists the pharaoh in locating and laying out the corners of a temple. She was also responsible for recording the names and tribute of captives taken in war. We often find her recording the pharaoh's name on the tree of life or recording the royal jubilees on a notched palm branch.

6. Explain how the ancient Egyptian people pictured this God. Use examples such as architecture, temples, statues, drawings, descriptions.

Pictured as a woman wearing a panther skin, her headdress consists of a star under a bow or bull horns. She is often holding a palm branch with the symbol of a jubilee pavilion hanging from it.



7. Explain how the people of ancient Egypt involved this God in their daily lives.
8. Recreate an ancient Egyptian architecture displaying the Egyptian God.
9. Explain how the role of this ancient Egyptian God and his or her involvement in *The Kane Chronicles*
10. Know the information, you will have to present to the class.

****Use images and or descriptions for each of the tasks on your project board****

Instructions:

1. Use ONE full sized poster board.
 - Any color poster board is accepted.
2. Type and print any text or image used on your poster board.
 - You may write the text but black ink and your best handwriting is recommended.
3. Use organization and creativity for your display.
 - Try and make the poster board as presentable as possible, you will receive a portion of your grade based on neatness.
4. The name of the book will be required on your poster board (#2 on your assignment sheet)
 - You may also include an image of the cover.
5. The name of the Egyptian God will be required on your poster board (#3 on your assignment sheet)
 - Be sure to include a picture. (This can be used as your image for #2 and #6 on your assignment sheet)
6. The title or specialty of the Egyptian God will be required on your poster board.
 - Example is on the assignment sheet under #4
7. In a well written paragraph, explain what this Egyptian God represents in the polytheistic religion.
 - Example is on the assignment sheet under #5
8. For #6 on your assignment sheet, use text and an image to explain how this Egyptian God was pictured by the people
 - Example is under #6 on the assignment sheet.
9. Using text, explain how this Egyptian God was involved in everyday life.
 - You may also include images to help explain
10. Create an architectural piece of the Egyptian God such as a statue, wall carving, or painting.
 - Use your creativity
 - The image can be created however you would like as long as it is on your poster board and not separate
11. Using text, explain the role of this Egyptian God in the Kane Chronicles.
12. Write your name and class period on the BACK of the poster board.
13. Print out and turn in the grade sheet with your presentation.
