## SCHOOL

St. Luke's Episcopal School was founded in 1961 as a mission of St. Luke's Episcopal Church. It is an independent, coed college preparatory school open to students of all races and creeds. Expanded to include an Upper School in 2009, the school currently enrolls 620 students in grades PK2-12. The school's first senior class graduated in May, 2013.

## ACCREDITATION

St. Luke's is dually accredited by the Southern Association of Independent Schools and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, and is a member of the National Association of Episcopal Schools and the Alabama Association of Independent Schools. It maintains affiliations with the Educational Records Bureau, National Association of Secondary School Principals, and the Southern Association of College Admissions Counselors.

## GRADUATION

All students must complete a minimum of 24 credits in addition to 24 CEU credits and 80 hours of community service.

## GRADE POINT AVERAGE

The Upper School cumulative GPA begins in the 9th grade continuing through the completion of the 12th grade. The GPA is calculated by averaging the semester grades of all numerically graded courses listed in the Upper School transcript. The GPA reflects the weighted grades of Honors and Advanced Placement courses. Each quarter grade counts 40% and each semester exam grade counts 20% of the semester average for grades 9-12. Semester grades of students who transfer are converted to match St. Luke's grade scale and weight system. Transcripts from other schools are attached to the St. Luke's transcript.
