



The Purpose of the Learning Lab

The purpose of the Learning Lab is to teach good study skills, such as test taking, note-taking, and solid work habits that help in the classroom. Your child has been diagnosed with a learning issue, therefore, it is sometimes more difficult to learn in a classroom with background noise or the speed of the class. The Learning Lab is an adjunct to the classroom where the students can review what they are learning. The lab is not a tutoring program. Modifications of the curriculum or the requirements to complete each grade are not possible. It is a program created to meet the accommodations that have been set by psycho-educational testing that must be on file. The goal of this program is to give each student the tools to make them successful on their own.

The Middle School Learning Lab

The Middle School Learning Lab is a class that meets daily. During each class, the student is responsible for identifying subjects where they are struggling, need extra practice, or general review. It is not set up for completion of homework. The Learning Lab instructor has constant communication with each student's teachers, but it is up to the parents to direct any questions on curriculum/grades to the individual teacher. The lab will provide quiet testing accommodations with extended time, if needed. Each student will sign a contract committing to completing homework, participating in class, a positive attitude, and outstanding classroom behavior. These are vital to the success of each student. The charge of the Middle School Learning Lab is \$500.00 per semester.

The High School Learning Lab

The High School Learning Lab is based on need. If a student needs a quiet atmosphere to prepare for a test or needs the instructor to review, the lab is setup to provide that. It is not a tutoring program. It is the responsibility of the student to make an appointment with the lab. This insures that each student enrolled in the lab receives the one-on-one help that they need. The Learning Lab will meet appropriate accommodations defined in the educational testing on file, such as distraction free and extended time testing. Each student will sign a contract committing to completing homework, participating in class, a positive attitude, and outstanding classroom behavior. These are vital to the success of each student. The charge of the High School Learning Lab is \$500.00 per semester.

High School Testing Accommodations Only

The High School Learning Lab offers testing only for accommodations defined by educational testing on file. This service is to provide distraction free testing with extended time. There is a charge of \$15 per test. The charge covers possible staff hiring to fill in for the lab instructor, as well as the organization between the lab and the teacher.
