The school year is divided into 2 semesters with each semester divided into 2 quarters. At the end of each quarter, a report card is distributed to the parents. Grades 9 – 12 will receive numerical grades in all subjects. Semester exams in core subjects will count as 20% of the semester average for grades 9-12. Parent Portal updates will report progress.

Seniors are required to earn 24 credits to graduate. Completion of each department's credit requirements is mandatory. Full credits are issued to students passing and completing yearly courses while ½ credits are issued for completing semester courses. Students are responsible for selecting courses carefully with the goal of complying with the required credit schedule. All graduates must earn credits through Algebra III in the Math Department and Biology, Chemistry and Physics in the Science Department.
